



# 2022 Mātāwaka Scholarship Application

**Closing date: 4pm, 8 April 2022**

---

The purpose of the Mātāwaka Scholarship is to encourage Māori of all ages and backgrounds to study at Otago Polytechnic and encourage them to succeed in tertiary education by removing financial barriers to study. This scholarship also acknowledges the contribution taura can make to their local community.

The scholarship will cover tuition fees for one stage of a learner's chosen programme of study at Otago Polytechnic. For those eligible for FeesFree (in lieu of tuition fees), \$4,000 will be paid towards accommodation costs (if staying at one of Otago Polytechnic's on-campus accommodation options) or \$2,000 towards course related costs. All successful recipients will be paired with a Tuakana (Māori Mentor) to guide them through their first year of studies. Further details will be given to successful recipients. There are a total of six (6) scholarships available in 2022.

## **Conditions of Application**

- Recipients of four (4) of these scholarships must be of New Zealand Māori descent, who **do not** have Kāi Tahu whakapapa
- Recipients of two (2) of these scholarships must be of New Zealand Māori descent, who **do** have Kāi Tahu whakapapa, but **do not** have whakapapa to one of the four local Rūnaka
- You must be enrolled as a Māori learner at Otago Polytechnic and be studying **full-time** for the **full year** in a chosen programme at Otago Polytechnic
- **You must be residing in the Otago region and studying at one of the Otago campuses** (i.e.: Dunedin or Cromwell)
- The Mātāwaka Scholarship pays the tuition fees for one year of study at Otago Polytechnic, or if eligible for FeesFree, a contribution towards accommodation or course related costs, as described above.
- If you have previously received a fee-paying Otago Polytechnic Scholarship, you are not eligible to apply for a Mātāwaka Scholarship.

## **Otago Polytechnic**

- Candidates must meet the academic entry criteria for their chosen programme of study (NB: If places on a course or programme are limited, normal selection criteria will apply).
- This scholarship applies to domestic learners only.
