OPTION 1

Suitable if you're new to carpentry.

New Zealand Certificate in Construction Trade Skills (Level 3) (Carpentry)

DURATION: 1 YEAR
LOCATION: DUNEDIN OR CROMWELL



New Zealand Certificate in Carpentry (Level 4) ITAB Apprenticeship

DURATION: 3-4 YEARS DEPENDING ON COMPETENCY
YEAR 1-2: START ON-SITE APPRENTICESHIP AT A WORKPLACE + BLOCK COURSES IN DUNEDIN OR CROMWELL
YEAR 3-4: ON-SITE APPRENTICESHIP AT A WORKPLACE



Assessments

Complete practical on-site apprenticeship assessments and theory assessments



OPTION 2

Suitable if you're already working in construction but don't have the qualification.

New Zealand Certificate in Carpentry (Level 4) ITAB Apprenticeship

DURATION: 3-4 YEARS DEPENDING ON COMPETENCY
YEAR 1-2: START ON-SITE APPRENTICESHIP AT A WORKPLACE + BLOCK COURSES IN DUNEDIN OR CROMWELL
YEAR 3-4: ON-SITE APPRENTICESHIP AT A WORKPLACE



Theory assessments

Attend theory block courses over three years of apprenticeship and complete theory assessments



Practical assessments

Complete practical on-site apprenticeship assessments
