- Be curious



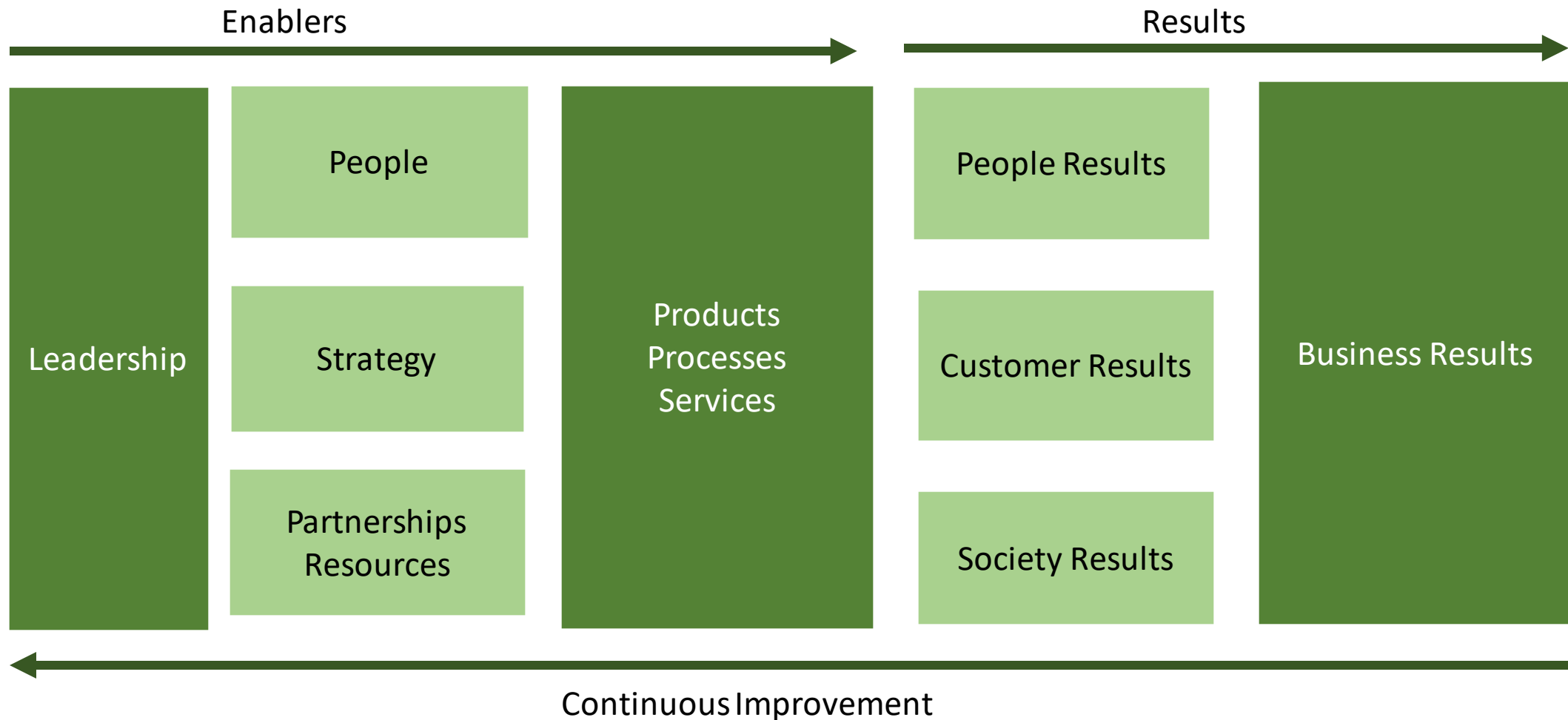

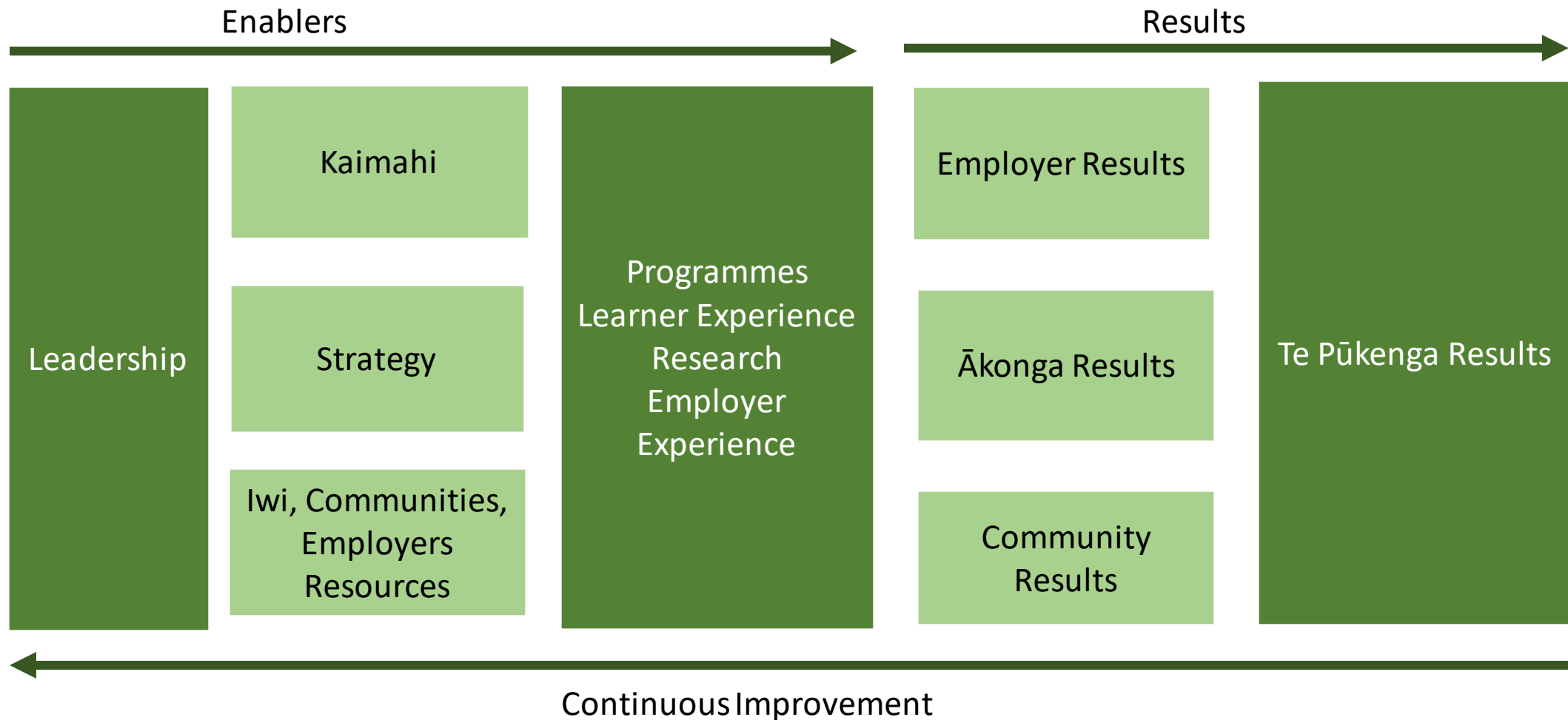
