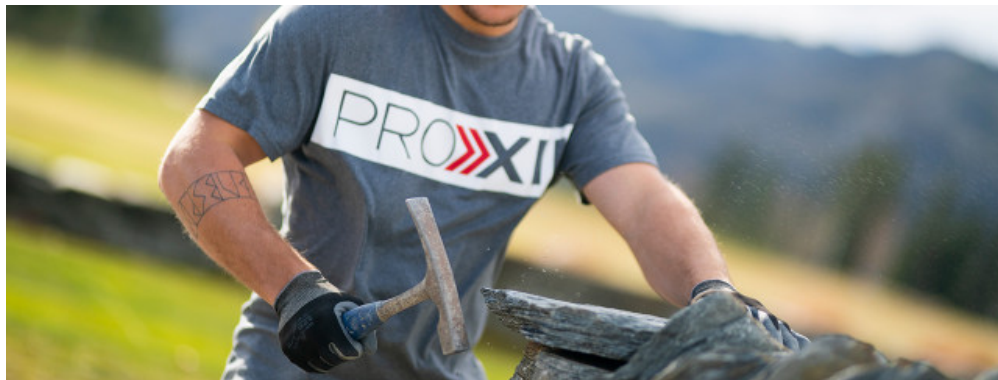


Dry stone walling short course
