This programme will give you a taste of what studying art and design is all about. You'll begin to build the skills and degree-level portfolio you need to apply for the Bachelor of Design (Communication or Fashion) or Bachelor of Visuals Arts, or to prepare for a junior role in a creative workplace.

You'll develop your research skills by studying art and design history, learn about creative processes and materials, explore idea development through drawing, illustration/cartoon and sculpture, and create your own art or design project which will be showcased in an exhibition.

To gain the well-rounded skills that are ideally needed for further art or design study, you can move into our New Zealand Certificate in Digital Media and Design (Level 4) or the New Zealand Certificate in Fashion (Level 4). Both of these programmes start in July and in combination with the New Zealand Certificate in Arts and Design (Level 4) create a strong pathway into:

- **Bachelor of Design ([Communication](#) or [Fashion](#))**
- **[Bachelor of Visual Arts](#), or**
- **[Level 5 video and photography diploma](#) (the New Zealand Diploma in Digital Media and Design Level 5).**

These all start in February.

By studying both Level 4 certificates, you'll also be gaining the creative skills that you need to be able to apply for our [Bachelor of Design \(Product\)](#) and our [Bachelor of Architectural Studies](#). These degrees need a different technical skillsset than our other art and design programmes. You'll need to achieve a very high level in both Level 4 certificates if you're keen to apply for either degree - just so we can make sure it's the right fit for you.
